The Group recorded a fair value loss of \$9.9 million in 2016 mainly due to a decrease in the market value of the Group's holding of Share Stapled Units ("SSUs") in HKT of \$9.6 million and a net decrease in the fair value of the Group's holding of other financial assets of \$0.3 million.

The Group recorded a fair value gain of \$5.0 million in 2015 mainly due to an increase in the fair value of the Group's holding of other financial assets of \$9.6 million partially offset by a decrease in the market value of the Group's holding of SSUs in HKT of \$4.8 million.

The Group's revenue for 2016 was \$13.0 million compared to \$11.5 million in 2015. The Group's revenue relates to dividends received from the Company's investment in HKT.

Total expenses in 2016 amounted to \$7.3 million compared to \$8.6 million in 2015. The difference is mainly due to the following reasons:-

- Legal and professional fees decreased from \$1.7 million in 2015 to \$1.2 million in 2016.
- The Group recorded foreign exchange gains of \$0.5 million compared to losses of \$0.9 million in 2015. The exchange gains in 2016 were mainly the result of realised exchange gains on the repayment of Hong Kong Dollar denominated loans arising from the strengthening of the Singapore Dollar against the Hong Kong Dollar at the beginning of the year.
- The above decreases were mainly offset by an increase in finance expense on bank borrowings. Finance costs in 2016 were \$3.7 million compared to \$3.0 million in 2015. The increase in finance costs was mainly due to front-end facility fees upon facility renewals during the financial year under review.

The Group's share of profit of associated corporations was \$82.7 million in 2016 compared to \$89.8 million in 2015. These included the Group's share of profit from PCCW of \$82.1 million in 2016 compared to \$89.6 million in 2015.

PCCW recorded a steady performance for 2016 amidst weak economic conditions and intensified competition across all core businesses.

PCCW's core revenue for the year ended 31 December 2016 decreased slightly by 2% to HK\$38,210 million (\$6,792.6 million) primarily due to a slowdown in Mobile handset sales. Excluding Mobile handset sales, core revenue increased by 2%. Core EBITDA increased by 3% to HK\$12,506 million (\$2,223.2 million) reflecting the successful completion of the CSL Holdings Limited ("CSL") integration at HKT and further investments in the over-the-top ("OTT") and Free TV segments within the Media Business.

PCCW's consolidated revenue for the year ended 31 December 2016 decreased by 2% to HK\$38,384 million (\$6,823.6 million) while consolidated EBITDA increased by 3% to HK\$12,226 million (\$2,173.4 million). Consolidated profit attributable to equity holders of PCCW was HK\$2,051 million (\$364.6 million).

HKT, the 63% subsidiary of PCCW, delivered a solid set of financial results for the year ended 31 December 2016, in the midst of an increasingly challenging macroeconomic environment and intensified market competition. This performance demonstrates the resilience of all of HKT's core businesses and reflects the strong execution across its operations during the year.

HKT's total revenue for the year ended 31 December 2016 decreased by 3% to HK\$33,847 million (\$6,017.0 million), impacted by lower revenue from Mobile handset sales due to the absence of marquee handsets throughout 2016. Excluding Mobile handset sales, its underlying revenue for the year increased by 3% to HK\$30,422 million (\$5,408.2 million). HKT's total EBITDA for the year was HK\$12,684 million (\$2,254.9 million), an increase of 5% over the previous year. Adjusted funds flow for the year ended 31 December 2016 amounted to HK\$4,683 million (\$832.5 million), an increase of 14% over the previous year.

The Group's share of profit of associated corporations for 2016 included the Group's share of a profit of \$0.6 million (2015: \$0.2 million) from its 49.87% Indian logistics associated corporation, KSH Distriparks Private Limited ("KSH").

The Group's profit attributable to equity holders for 2016 was \$87.0 million compared to \$91.0 million for 2015.

The results of the Group are substantially dependent on the results of the Group's major investment, PCCW.

PCCW will continue to reinforce the leadership position of its core businesses of telecommunications, media and IT solutions in Hong Kong. HKT will focus on building upon the strength of its network and service offerings locally, while the Media and IT Solutions Businesses plan to forge a strong footprint in the region.

As a trusted partner for its customers, PCCW Solutions has fortified its track record of delivering consistent revenue growth and industry leading margins. PCCW Solutions aims to grow with its customers by assisting them to become digital enterprises. It is well positioned to act as a gateway for customers to expand their presence in mainland China and for mainland enterprises to expand globally. In addition, PCCW Solutions will continue to enrich its cloud capabilities, expand its data centre infrastructure, and offer solutions tailor-made for its key industry sectors.

The Now TV Business will solidify its leading position in Hong Kong by enriching its content offering and user interface, integrating seamlessly with HKT's superior network to offer the most compelling and reliable media viewing experience in Hong Kong.

The growing OTT Business aims to further raise customer awareness and engagement, broaden its library of locally relevant content and expand into selected new markets to capture opportunities arising from the changing viewing habits of customers.

The Free TV Business has been well received by viewers and advertisers as a fresh alternative. PCCW will continue to invest in the production of appealing programs and make the content available on multiple delivery platforms. However, PCCW remains cautious towards this competitive market particularly with the imminent entry of a new player.

The outlook for 2017 is overshadowed by global events, execution of the Brexit mechanism, and the change in leadership of the United States. Within Hong Kong, PCCW has yet to see a strong return of consumer and business confidence.

In 2016, PCCW successfully implemented a number of initiatives in Hong Kong and in the region, planting seeds for the PCCW Group's future growth and development. In 2017, PCCW will continue to identify suitable opportunities and monitor the external environment carefully to deliver value to shareholders. Given the dynamic environment, PCCW will invest prudently.
